Butte in Pawnee National Grassland

Today (June 6, 2008) we did a day hike in the Pawnee National Grassland near the spot where Wyoming, Nebraska, and Colorado come together. Two buttes (“East” and “West”) rise up out of the grasslands in a remote and beautiful area full of spring wildflowers.

The parking area at the end of a gravel road is next to an open range for cattle. The hike is about 3-4 miles round trip, and the trail goes between bluffs where hawks and eagles nest in the spring, along a wash lined with junipers, and across grasslands to the base of the buttes.

Nearby are a couple of ranches and a wind turbine farm.
