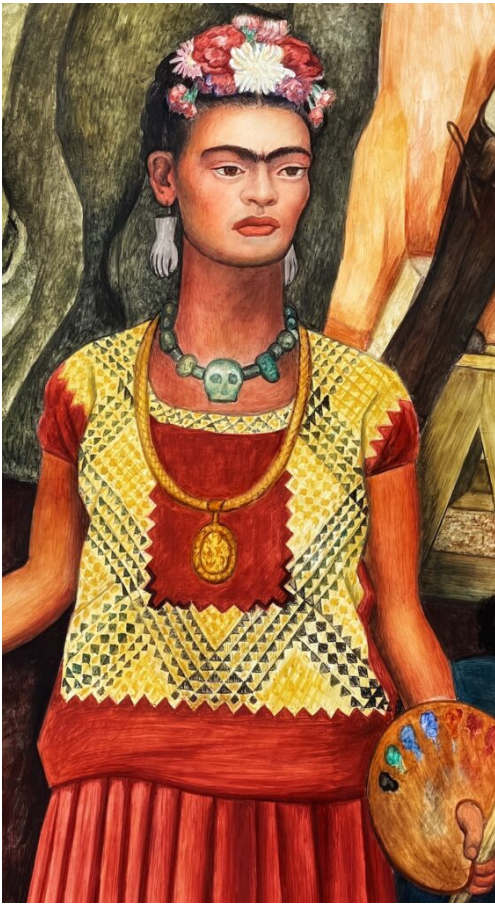
LUNCH IN SAN FRANCISCO AND VISIT TO SFMOMA

On September 15 we had lunch in “the City” (as we Bay Area types call it) and visited the San Francisco Museum of Art (SFMOMA). Of particular interest to us that day was a mural titled “Pan American Unity,” which was painted in 1940 by the Mexican artist, Diego Rivera. The mural, which was painted not on a wall but on steel-framed cement panels, will be on display in the museum’s lobby until January 2024.
